Empowering young people in Haiti to thrive and achieve their potential



Our 3 Focuses

We take a wholistic approach, providing a support system that equips students for success.

Education

We pay for students' tuition, uniforms, books, and school supplies. Additionally, we provide a monthly stipend for lunches and transportation to and from school.

Technology

At our technology resource center, students can access laptops, high-speed internet, and electricity. This is a safe space where they can study, do online research, and connect with other students.

Mentoring

We match university students with qualified personal mentors who provide guidance and support. This is especially valuable for young people in Haiti who are often the first people in their families to get a university education.



Our Impact

(July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023)

33 Sponsored Students

All of these students' educational expenses were covered, and they were given a stipend for food and transportation.

31 families

When we pay for a student's education, their entire family benefits because this frees up money for other expenses.

360 resource center registrations

All of these people plus an unknown number of non-registered guests accessed computers and internet at our resource center.

2667 resource center visits

Total number of visits to our resource center that were logged in our guestbook this year. This does not include group classes and events.

Education

Students receive ...

Tuition

100% of the student's tuition is covered. K-12 students are also enrolled in a meal plan if this is offered by the school.

Books and Supplies

All students receive books and school supplies, and university students also receive personal laptops.

Uniforms

We purchase uniforms for all K-12 students and for university students if necessary.

Monthly Stipends

Students receive a monthly stipend to help with the cost of lunches and transportation.



Education

We supported a total of **33 students**, and our goal is to support students all the way from kindergarten to college graduation.

18 University Students

We supported 10 university students in our home base of Jeremie, and 8 university students in Port-au-Prince.

11 Elementary Students

We supported 7 elementary students in Jeremie (including 1 high school student), and 4 elementary students in Port-au-Prince.

4 Kindergarten Students

We supported 4 kindergarten students. In Haiti, kindergarten is a 3-year program.

3 University Graduates

3 of the 18 university students that we supported this year graduated from college!

Jeremie, Haiti

Our technology resource center is located in the town of Jeremie on the campus of our community partner the Beraca Education Center. Here we provide a safe, pleasant place where students access laptops, highspeed internet, and consistent electricity.

The Beraca campus consists of a kindergarten, elementary school, and university. All of the Beraca university students have access to our resource center, and younger children can use it under the supervision of adults or volunteers.

We also make this space available to local professionals and students from other universities when space permits.

In addition, we host mentor/mentee meetings, seminars, training events, and university classes. Our goal is to create a welcoming environment that is conducive to learning.



What We Provide

High-Speed Internet

We use Starlink which is the most powerful and consistent internet in Haiti. It supports streaming, video-conferencing, and browsing on many devices.

Laptops

Students can use laptops at our resource center for free, and if they have a personal laptop they can come and connect to our wireless network.

Solar Powered Electricity

Our resource center is completely solarpowered, so we have 24/7 electricity even though the city of Jeremie does not.

Clean Drinking Water

We provide treated drinking water free for all of our guests.



Hosted Events - Resource Center

University Classes

We host university classes 4 evenings per week. Our Resource Center is one of the few places with a big screen and high-speed internet, so it is highly sought after.

Computer Skills for Children

We have a basic computer skills class for elementary students once per week.

Special Events

We host special events such as training events, seminars, and workshops for young people and adults.

Thrive Ansanm Meetings

We also use this space for meetings for our staff, volunteers, and mentors/mentees.

Mentoring

How it Works

11 Student + 11 Mentors

Each of our university students (and one high school student) in Jeremie is matched with a personal mentor. They meet at least once per month and communicate via text.

Monthly Mentoring Meetings

All of the mentors/mentees meet approximately once per month. During these meetings, students and mentors have the chance to share and discuss as a group.

Guided Resources

Students and mentors use a simple curriculum that guides them through the process of identifying their long-term goals, talents, values, and how these all relate. We also offer resources to help students collaborate with their mentors to cultivate healthy study habits and relationships at school.






Our Financial Investment
